

Retreat Committee Report for September 22, 2019 board meeting.

We met on August 25 and September 8. We had 20 people registered but one person has since cancelled, although we may be able to replace that person with another. In any case the venue let us know that they would accept us coming even if we had less than 20 people. We have 5 speakers planned and also plan to have a panel in which 4 people will speak on "the gifts of the program". We decided to record the retreat. We also plan on having a "marketplace" in which gently used items are sold, with funds donated to the GSA. These items will be donated by members.

Members have agreed to sell the literature on behalf of the Office Manager. We will be selling it for 2 x 30-minute periods which should suffice as we are a relatively small group. There have been no requests for bulk orders.
